Jesus, who teaches us to follow the **unitive path of love**, help us gently to put our minds into our hearts,

to know you more instinctively through intuition and revelation, not only through doctrine and dogma.

We pray for the families of Denishee Witbooi and Meghan Cremer who were so cruelly murdered.

As we remember them we hold them to your Light and Grace.

We pray for those who are disabled may we learn from them as they are included in our circles of community.

We remember this month the brothers, uncles, cousins, fathers, sons who were shot down at Marikana. Comfort those who mourn.
