Sinesipho is a joyful, loving child who is full of respect.

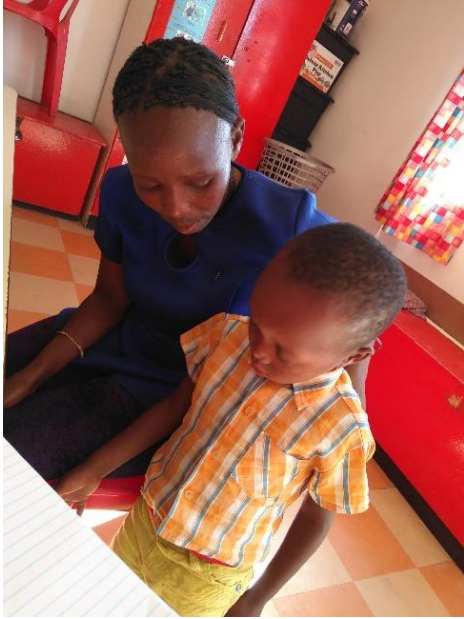


Phelokazi Mkhwetha (25 years old)
